KICK GOALS ON SUBIACO OVAL!

Our venue for the event is Subiaco Oval, the former home of WA's two AFL Football teams and venue for major sporting events and concerts in Perth. The old grandstands have been pulled down now to make way for landscaped public space.

Subiaco is a fantastic location. It's just 2.5km from the Perth CBD (6 minute drive) and is right alongside the Subiaco Square train station and bus station. There is access for coaches, and nearby Mueller Park provides a massive shaded area for band tuning.

Subiaco Oval is walking distance from hotel accomodation including Vibe Hotel Subiaco, Holiday Inn West Perth, Tribe Perth Kings Park, Quest Kings Park, Quest on Rheola, The Sebel West Perth, Wheeler Apartments, and Perth City Apartment Hotel.



EXTEND YOUR STAY AND HOLIDAY IN WA.

Perth offers some wonderful tourism experiences for those who can stay a little while after the Championships.

The Perth CBD has a range of accommodation options from family budget hotels to internationally renowned luxury hotels such as Como The Treasury, The Ritz Carlton on Elizabeth Quay, and Crown Towers. You can also stay in our eclectic port city of Fremantle, alive with character pubs and vibrant multicultural restaurants. Just 40 minutes by ferry is Rottnest Island, home of the famous Quokkas and stunning bays with white sand and crystal clear waters. The Swan Valley wine region is also 40 minutes from the Perth CBD and offers a range of accommodation options.



Further afield are WA's iconic tourist destinations such as Esperance and Albany with impossibly white beaches, the Margaret River wine region, the historic Kalgoorlie Goldfields, the Coral Coast featuring Monkey Mia where dolphins visit daily, and Exmouth where you can swim with whale sharks. The Pilbara offers the wonderous gorges of Karijini National Park, plus the Kimberley Region is home to the idyllic tropical paradise of Broome and the famous Bungle Bungles at Purnululu National Park.
