Bands please note:

1. All Band Representatives to sign in with Contest Supervisor prior to competing. Bands not signed in by that time may be assumed not to be competing and draw may be adjusted accordingly.
2. All bands will be required to verify their playing roster, including Dual Registered players, Tutors and interchange Players in advance of playing. Bands can anticipate a penalty of 2 place points per player per element for each unregistered or incorrectly registered player.
3. The Contest timetable for this event is tight. Please assist by being timely to the line and marching off swiftly when directed *otherwise you will be responsible for everyone standing in the cold and dark in Massed band*.
4. Fine tuning, will be at the back of the Contest Oval behind the Band tents marked on the diagram.
5. Dress will be judged during the MSR / SOM. Bands must hold fast until released. Dual Registered players are required to wear the uniform of the band they are playing with.
6. March Off Drill Contest will be conducted after the Medley Element in accordance with Part B, Chapter 9 of the [Pipe Bands Australia Contest Regulations - 1 March 2026](#).
7. Bands are **required** to play off during Drill (Medley) element and **not required** to play off after the MSR Element when released by Contest Supervisor.
8. Bands will be selected for random registration checks at completion of march off after any Element. A Band so selected will hold fast after marching off until released by Contest Supervisor.
