2. Fine tuning, will be at the back of the Showgrounds marked red on the diagram.
3. Dress will be judged during the MSR / SOM. Bands must hold fast until released.
4. March Off Drill Contest will be conducted after the Medley Element for all but NJB in accordance with Part B, Chapter 9 of the [Pipe Bands Australia - Contest Regulation - Effective 1 March 2026](#).
5. Bands are required to play off during Drill element and encouraged to play off after the Medley Element when released by Contest Supervisor.
6. Bands will be selected for random registration checks at completion of march off after any Element. A Band so selected will hold fast after marching off until released by Contest Supervisor.
